The gold standard for control of insects, mites, and many diseases.



Plant Recovery~ Pre and Post Emergent Weed Control and Fertilizer for Turf and Beds

Eliminate weed competition and apply a post-emergent weed control such as Image All-In-One Lawn Weed Killer. Also, treat with Halts pre-emergent for turf and Preen for beds to control germinating weeds. Fertilize to encourage recovery and vigor with a slow-release fertilizer.

Selecting Fall Color ~ Marigolds

If you want to create a color scheme for this Fall to get you into a festive mood, a combination of marigolds and crotons all have great fall colors. There are many varieties of marigolds and crotons to make your selection from.





Selecting Fall Color ~ Crotons

Embed crotons among the marigolds to create more interest. You can plant these in beds and pots at this time. A few pumpkins and bales of hay can round out your fall look. These plants will die at the first freeze, so don't get too attached, but enjoy the beauty while it lasts.





Tips for your Landscape

- Mulch beds and tree rings to improve appearance, conserve moisture, and provide protection from line trimmer damage, mower damage and winter freeze
- Prune trees for shape and corrective pruning
- Fertilize trees to encourage vigor
- Prepare seasonal color beds for fall and winter planting
- Add decorations to landscape for fall interest
- Fall is the best time to plant or replace trees!
