

Pool Rules

ACCESS:

Access to the pool/amenities is for members of the Wolf Ranch Community Association that are in good standing and their guests only.

GUESTS:

Guests are welcome but must be accompanied by a Wolf Ranch homeowner/resident.

A maximum of five (5) guests are allowed per household.

HOURS:

5:00AM - 10:00PM Open Swim

- 1. **NO LIFEGUARD** on duty. Swim at your own risk.
- 2. Family-friendly swimwear required. Swim attire must be clean, modest, and designated for pool use. No undergarments, thongs, overly revealing garments or street clothes allowed.
- 3. Children under the age of 14 MUST be accompanied by a resident, 18 years or older, possessing a valid pool access device.
- 4. A resident, 18 years or older, possessing a valid pool access device, MUST accompany all guests.
- 5. Persons with skin diseases, open sores or wounds, inflamed eyes, nasal or ear infections or any communicable diseases are not allowed to use the pool.
- 6. For the health and safety of the residents, rubber pants in addition to swim diapers are **REQUIRED** for all non-toilet trained children.
- 7. **NO** diving, running, jumping, cannonballs, or similar entries in the pool allowed.
- 8. NO laying on, standing, sitting, jumping or rolling off the infinity edge tiled pool wall allowed.
- 9. **NO** running, roughhousing, climbing trees or general horseplay in the pool area.
- 10. Pets are **NOT** allowed with the exception of guide dogs.
- 11. NO smoking, vaping, or other tobacco products of any kind, and no gum allowed.
- 12. **NO** glass objects of any kind are allowed in the pool area.
- 13. **NO** propping open of any pool entrance and no opening of pool entrances for anyone outside of the pool facility.
- 14. **DO NOT** ride bikes, tricycles, scooters, hover boards, roller blades or skateboards in the pool area.
- 15. Traditional beach balls only, no oversized flotation devices, including rafts.
- 16. Foul language and/or threatening behavior will **NOT** be tolerated.
- 17. Music and other noise **MUST** be maintained at a low level at all times.
- 18. Emergency equipment is to be used for emergencies only.
- 19. NO trespassing after pool hours or during pool closures.
- 20. The Homeowners Association or Management Company is not responsible for accidents, injuries or theft.
- 21. **VANDALISM WILL NOT BE TOLERATED**. To report vandalism, call police immediately, then notify Management Company.
- 22. In case of **EMERGENCY, CALL 911**
- 23. Violation of pool rules may lead to revoking of pool privileges and/or criminal prosecution.
